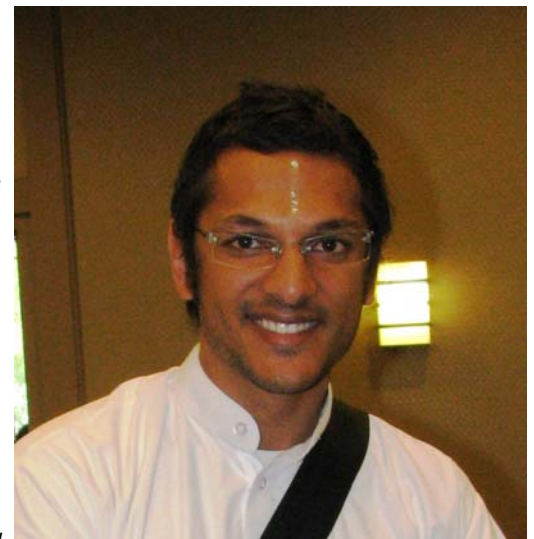
About Acharya Vivek Gupta:
